

# Message

Dear Friends and Benefactors, Greetings from Thuckalay diocese!

The Syro-Malabar Church rejoices and thanks for having received its new Shepherd to lead the church in the person of Bishop Raphael Thattil, as Major Archbishop. Bishop Raphael Thattil was installed as Major Archbishop of the Syro-Malabar Church at a solemn concelebrated Mass at the Church headquarters at Mount St. Thomas, Kakkanad, on 11 January 2024, Thursday.

The Session of the Synod which started on 8 January 2024, having completed the canonical procedures of electing the new Major Archbishop on the second day, sent the Synodal letter addressed to the Holy Father Pope Francis, through the Apostolic Nunciature, signed by all the participants of the Session, together with the letter of the Major Archbishop-elect, in his own handwriting, requesting the confirmation of the Holy Father for his election. Having received the confirmation of the Holy Father, the Major Archbishop-elect made the profession of faith and act of fidelity before the Synod Fathers. Then the election Session of the Synod was concluded and the Synod Fathers proceeded to announcement of the election of the Major Archbishop. On Wednesday, at 4.30 pm on 10 January 2024, Archbishop Mar Moolakkatt, the president of the Election Session, announced that Bishop Raphael Thattil, currently the Bishop of Shamshabad, is elected the fourth Major Archbishop of the Syro-Malabar Church.

He was born to Ouseph and Thresia on 21 April 1956 and was baptized on 30 April 1956 in Thrissur. Lazar (late), Thomas, Baby (late) Francis, Sosannam, Joy and John, are his brothers and sisters. After his primary education at St. Thomas College HS, Thrissur, he joined St. Mary's Minor Seminary, Thope on 04 July 1971. He completed his study of Philosophy and Theology in St. Thomas Ap. Seminary Kottayam in 1980. He was ordained by Mar Joseph Kundukulam in Thrissur Doloures Basilica. on 21 December 1980. He did his higher studies in Rome and took doctorate in Oriental Canon Law. His thesis was on "Clerical Formation in the Syro Malabar Church: A Historico-Juridical Study".



After his ordination he served as Asst. Vicar, Aranattukara (1981-82), Fr. Prefect & Asst. Procurator, St Mary's Minor Seminary (1982-83), Acting Vicar, Koonammoochy (1983), Acting Vicar, Cherumkuzhy (1983). On returning back from Rome, he served in the Archbishop's house as Vice Chancellor, Chancellor, Adj. Judicial Vicar, Judge and later as Syncellus and Proto-Syncellus. He was the director of DBCLC & Catechism (1992-1995). On 20 January1998, he was appointed as the project officer of the new Marymatha Major Seminary, after a few months appointed as the first Rector of the Marymatha Seminary (1998-2006). He also worked as president and member of many a committees and commissions.

He was ordained as Bishop on 10 April 2010 and appointed as Auxiliary bishop of Trichur and Titular Bishop of Bruni. In 2014, he was appointed as Apostolic visitor for the Syro-Malabar faithful residing outside the territorium proprium. Pope Francis named him the first Bishop of the Syro-Malabar Catholic Eparchy of Shamshabad on 10 October 2017 and he was installed on 7 January 2018. The diocese of Thuckalay expresses congratulations and best wishes to the newly appointed Major Archbishop.

His Beatitude Cardinal George Alencherry has been a pillar of strength and a revered figure, serving as the father and head of the Syro-Malabar Church for the past 12 years. His dedication and tireless efforts have played a pivotal role in fostering unity and ensuring the growth of the Syromalabar Church globally. The Diocese of Thuckalay expresses deep gratitude for Cardinal Alencherry's leadership, wisdom, and commitment to the spiritual well-being of the Syromalabar community. His tenure has been marked by a profound sense of responsibility and a genuine desire to strengthen the bonds of unity and faith among the Syro-Malabar diocese and faithful.

# **Celebrating a century of blessings:** Syro-Malabar Hierarchy's radiant journey

Pope Pius XI established the Syro-Malabar Hierarchy on December 21, 1923 by his decree, Romani Pontifices. The growth of the Syro-Malabar Church after the establishment of the Hierarchy with Ernakulam as the Archeparchy and Trichur, Changanacherry, and Kottayam as the Suffragan Eparchies has been phenomenal. Even though the Syro-Malabar Church had pastoral jurisdiction all over India until the 16th century, which underwent restrictions later for four centuries, has now been restored. It should be especially remembered that the two events, the establishment of the Vicariates in 1887 and of the hierarchy in 1923 accelerated the development of our Church. We shall remember with gratitude the blessings the Syro-Malabar Church has received through the establishment of the Hierarchy.

In accordance with the directives received from Mar Sebastian Vaniyapurackal, the Administrator of the Syro-Malabar Church, in our diocese, we celebrated a Thanksgiving Holy Qurbana to mark the centenary celebrations of the establishment of the Syro-Malabar Hierarchy. The event took place on December 21, 2023, at 5:30 pm at Sacred



Heart Forane Church, Padanthalumoodu. Rev. Bishop served as the main celebrant, and Rev. Fr. Jose Muttathupadam delivered the homily. Fr. Anil Raj also concelebrated, and Provincial Superiors, along with other Superiors, participated as representatives of religious sisters. Representatives of the lay faithful from the Padanthalumoodu Forane parishes were also in attendance.

The Diocese organized a series of Pre-Christmas celebrations. On December 9, we hosted Christmas Celebrations at Sangamam with the departments of catechesis, CML, and Kuzhanthai Isso Iyakkam. A Christmas gathering with migrants took place on December 10 in Chennai. On December 12, Christmas celebrations were held at Sangamam with the Heads of Institutions, and on the same evening, a Christmas celebration was organized for the staff of the Sychar Resource Centre at Kozhiporvilai. Another Christmas gathering with Irai Arul staff occurred at the Bishop's House on December 13, with CRI members and Mathru Jyothis members at Kattathurai on December 16, and with the missionaries of Tenkasi Mission at Pudur on the same day evening. On December 17, a Christmas celebration with the missionaries of extended territories took place in Madurai, and on December 19, a celebration with the heads of charitable institutions was held. Further Christmas gatherings included one with the Seeds members and Minor Seminarians at Mukkottukal Seminary on December 22 and with Major seminarians at the Bishop's House on the evening of December 23. The neighborhood around the Bishop's House celebrated Christmas on December 23.











On December 19, 2023, the Priests of the Eparchy gathered at Sangamam to celebrate Christmas and strengthen our sense of brotherhood. From 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm, there was an opportunity for confession and adoration. The get-together commenced with a Priests' Conference at 4:30 pm. During the first half of the Priests Conference, the Presbyterium officially expressed gratitude on behalf of the diocese to Mar George Cardinal Alencherry, the Major Archbishop Emeritus of the Syro-Malabar Church. During the Priests' Conference, Fr. Mathew Thekkekuttu and Fr. Thomas Sathianesan shared their experiences with Cardinal Mar George Alencherry, expressing the gratitude of the entire presbyterium. During the concluding talk, Rev.Bishop thanked him for his significant contributions as the first bishop of Thuckalay and his remarkable service to the Syro-Malabar Church as the Major Archbishop for the past 12 years.

explanation of the discussions and decisions made during the last Presbyteral Council. Additionally, Fr. Justin Cheruvelil briefly discussed the history and significance of the centenary celebrations of the establishment of the Syro-Malabar Hierarchy. The presbyterium also congratulated Fr. Jinu Thekkethala on his recent appointment by the Prefect in the Vatican Dicastery of Communication.

Following the Priests' Conference, all the Fathers processed from the chapel to the hall, singing carols, with the junior priests and deacons organizing the event. At the beginning of the gathering, all the Fathers joined together to cut the Christmas cake and share it. Fr. Sebastian Pothenparampil MST delivered the Christmas message. Each Father revealed the name of their Christmas friend and exchanged gifts. The program concluded with a family meal.

Throughout her service, she made significant contributions to various ministries in different locations: Arukani and Anamugham (1970 – 2003), Varuthattu School Headmistress (2003 - 2008), Palugal and Anamugham (2008 - 2015), and Mukkoottukal (2015 - 2018). The funeral service for Sr. Dorethi SH took place on December 17, 2023, at 12:00 noon at St. Mathew's SH Province House in Changanacherry. From our diocese, Rev. Fr. Thomas Powathuparampil, the Vicar General, participated and delivered the homily. Representatives from the clergy and lay faithful, where she had rendered her ministry, visited and offered prayers at her tomb. Rev.Bishop presided over a remembrance Holy Qurbana and the Office of the Dead at her tomb on December 18, 2023, Monday.






# Honoring the Spiritual Shepherd:

#### Rev. Fr. John Thekkel

With deep sorrow, we received the heartbreaking news of the passing of one of the great missionaries of our diocese, Fr. John Thekkel, on December 21, 2023, at 3:45 pm. Immediately following his demise, arrangements were made to pay final respects to Fr. John Thekkel and organize the funeral ceremony. The mortal remains of Fr. John Thekkel were placed at Sangamam Chapel from 7:00 pm on December 21 until 9:00 am on December 22. Subsequently, it was taken to Sacred Heart Forane Church, Padanthalumoodu, and kept there for paying

final respects until 7:00 am on December 23.

Throughout the day, time slots were allocated for each Forane to visit the mortal remains and bid their last respects. On December 23 at 7:00 am, his body was taken to St. Francis Assisi Church, Mezhacode, for the funeral ceremony. The first part of the ceremony commenced at 10:00 am in front of the FCC convent, Mezhacode, during which Fr. Mathew Kuzhinjalil delivered a message. Following the first part, a procession moved to the parish church. The second part occurred in the church, and the Holy Qurbana was concelebrated by all priests. Rev. Bishop Mar George Rajendran SDB presided the Holy Qurbana and delivered the homily. After the Holy Qurbana, the concluding part of the funeral took place, with a procession around the church and then to the cemetery. Priests, Sisters, and laity paid their respects to Fr. John Thekkel. Family members of Fr. John were present, along with almost all the Fathers, Sisters, and lay faithful from the parishes and institutions where he had served. Rev. Sisters accompanied the mortal remains of Fr. John throughout the day and night






under the guidance of CRI. Special thanks to all the Fathers of different committees who organized the funeral ceremony, especially Fr. Vinod Kanakkalil, Sangamam director; Fr. Lijo Thekkel, Mezhacode Parish Priest; Fr. Geo Choozhikunnel, TPWA treasurer; and Fr. Joshy Kulathumkal, President, TPWA.

Fr. John Thekkel was one of the great missionaries who dedicated himself tirelessly to the advancement of the Kingdom of God, playing a pivotal role in the development of the Kanyakumari mission and later of the Diocese of Thuckalay. Born on November 20, 1934, he belonged to Sacred Heart Church, Peringulam, of the Diocese of Palai. Ordained a priest on March 14, 1966, he spent 7 years in ministry in the Archdiocese of Changanacherry. His active ministry in the Kanyakumari mission began in 1973, lasting until his official retirement in 2013. Fr. John Thekkel rendered his ministry in the following places: Jaya Matha Church, Nithiravilai & St. Antony's Church, Vayalinkarai(1973 – 1974); St. Xavier's Church, Varuthattu, St. George Church, Munchirai & Correspondent MMKM School, Varuthattu (1976 – 1989); Holy Cross Church, Malaicode & St. Martin de Porres Church, Kazhuvanthittai (1989 - 1997); Holy Family



Church, Mukkoottukal, St. Joseph's Church, Karode & Correspondent Holy Family H.S. Mukkoottukal (1997 – 1998); St. Maria Goretti Church, Athencode (1998 - 2003); St. Francis Assisi Church, Mezhacode (2003 - 2013). Secretary KKSSS, Padanthalumoodu (1976 -1979); Secretary KKSSS, Kalluvilai (1997 – 2003); Retirement life in Sangamam (2013 - 2023).
