Message

Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,

Greetings and prayerful wishes from Diocese of Thuckalay.

In my message this month I would like to reflect with you, in short, the reality of death and how one needs to prepare for the same. When facing the end of life or the loss of a loved one, the first step is to recognize one's feelings about death. Taking the time to grieve is also important, as it is connecting with and communicating with others. Isolation can make things more difficult.

There is a natural longing in the human heart for peace, friendship, love and happiness; for a life that is purposeful and worth living. And there is an even deeper longing and yearning to discover the ultimate meaning of life, to know the love of God, and to share in a destiny beyond the horizon of death. St Augustine of Hippo, one of the great teachers of the Church, wrote: "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in You." In God's plan, human beings are created for holiness and eternal life with him through death.

The mystery of death is of all the fears that plague the heart of man; none is greater than the fear of death. It is our greatest fear, the sum of all other fears. We are afraid to die. We are afraid of what happens when we die. Death is a fundamental human problem, but many also have a conviction that something lies beyond it, that death does not have the last word. The Catholic Faith is rooted in the belief that God has made us enjoy life with Him. Every Christian hopes to die in a state of grace, reconciled with God, self and at peace with others. The Bible says that God "desires all people to be saved" (1 Timothy 2:4).

"I am the Resurrection and the Life. Those who believe in Me, even though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die" (Jh 11: 25-26). The final goal of our lives is to see God face to face in heaven, to be wrapped up in His joy, love and happiness forever in the company of all the angels and saints.

As we enter the month of November, let us meaningfully spend the month helping our people to pray for their dead and assisting our dying members to reach the Heavenly Home. It is such a consolation to know that we are spiritually united, even now, with those who have died, and that we have the hope of seeing them again in Heaven when we die ourselves. It is also an appropriate time for us to reflect upon the temporality of human life and get ourselves of all unnecessary baggage that we carry which can distract us from our goal, namely, the heavenly Jerusalem, where moth and rust consume and where thieves break in and steal (Mt 6:19).

We have joyfully celebrated the **26<sup>th</sup> Diocesan Day** on 13 November 2022. Our hearts, "Give thanks to the Lord, call on His name. Make known His deeds among the peoples; make them remember that His name is exalted." Praise the Lord in song, for He has done glorious things; let this be known throughout the earth (Isaiah 12:4-5). Thanksgiving is a joyous invitation to shower the world with love, togetherness and gratitude. The Diocese rejoices over the 26 years of the steadfast love of God and for the many blessings.

While I am grateful to all the priests, religious and faithful of the Diocese, I thank all the friends and benefactors of the Diocese for playing an important role in the building up of the Diocese. As we march towards another year, lets us implore God's unconditional love, accompaniment, guidance and support to be a joyful witness in the synodal Church to transform the world towards God's Kingdom. May God bless each and every one of you.

#### My Discovery and Living the True Faith Mrs Reena Satheesh

#### Praise the Lord! Hallelujah

The Lord is my Shepherd; I shall not want (Psalm 23:1)

I am Reena Satheesh and I am originally from Thettiyode, Thuckalay Diocese and currently I am working as a nurse in Bahrain. My husband Satheesh works in A to Z contracting company in central AC ducting

section. We have three children Evangelin Mary, Dominic Savio and Elsa Mary. Evangelin and Dominic are studying in an Asian school, Bahrain in 9th and 3rd Grades and Elsa Mary is 3years of age.

It is with great pleasure I pen for the first time to share with someone about my life and how I was touched by the Catholic Faith.

I was born and brought up in a non-Catholic family and more specifically we belonged to an evangelical church, where Mother Mary was not venerated. During my childhood, I used to go to our nearby evangelical church. It was so interesting for me to attend Sunday's Bible classes and the explanation of Bible stories by the teachers. One Sunday evenings when I was studying in 7thstandard,I got a chance to watch a movie on Velankanni Matha (Our Lady of Health, Velankanni). As usual, the movie was so interesting. Besides, there was something else that touched profoundly my heart. Till then I had never heard about Mother Mary and her apparition in Velankanni. As my family was so orthodox in the evangelical church, I was also afraid of asking more about Mother Mary to anyone in the family. But the image always remained in my heart.

I continued my studies and passed the higher secondary examination with distinction. Then I joined Sree Mookambika College of Nursing for B.Sc Nursing and completed in 2004. Later I started my career as a professional nurse. But I was so frustrated about my future, thinking about different issues in he family, the low income, debts of my father, etc. So frequently I used to go and pray in nearby churches during my leisure time and holidays. Unexpectedly all these churches were Catholic Churches and again those images of Mother Mary imprinted in my heart after the movie, returned powerfully. I started praying, to intercedefor her help with all the intentions. Miraculously one day, Mother Mary gave me a vision promising me help to resolve all my problems. After all these events, I came home for holidays and my family was getting ready to present me for my marriage to a boy from Thettiyode in May 2005. It was a great joy in my life that he belonged to a Catholic family. It was the first miracle that I experienced after my relation with Mother Mary personally in my life. Today I believe that all these are beyond human knowledge and comprehension. It is only faith and trust that will help us to cooperate with the Divine plan in our life. Gradually she started removing each obstacle in my life.



Thereafter, with the help of the Parish especially priests and religious, I started learning Catholic prayers like Holy Mass, Rosary, Novena, prayers for the souls in purgatory, the intercession of the Holy Spirit, Divine Mercy chaplet, consecration to Immaculate Heart of Mary and Sacred Heart of Jesus, etc. It was not easy in the beginning but once I learned all these prayers, I have never ceased my routine prayer life.

After ten months of marriage, we went together to Bahrain for our jobs. I started working in a hospital. There were many difficulties we faced during those initial years. Many days I was left alone during work. I strongly believe that Our Blessed Mother Mary was my companion every moment. She protected me always, especially when I was working in the psychiatric department. There were times when patients were so agitated and violent and I could have managed alone all these situations as I was spiritually accompanied by the Holy Family.

Another major trial in my life was the last pregnancy. Doctors suggested to avoid the baby deforming inside the uterus. But I believed in God more and more and trusted in intercession and counsel of Our Mother Mary. One of the Bible verses which I repeatedly recited during those months was, "The Holy Spirit will come on you and the power of the MostHigh will overshadow you" (Luke 1:35). Today our great joy is with this third child is 3years old now. She is the reason to draw me more and more to Jesus. Whenever I am distressed and unable to pray, she always





brought me in front of the Blessed Sacrament or the Holy Cross and helps me to overcome all sorrowful situations.

Today I rejoice in my Lord through Mother Mary. My family is also so attentive to pious and devotional and spiritual activities. The lead taken by my older two children in spiritual activities helps a lot in the formation of the third child. Even at home, we decorate images and statues of Jesus, Mother Mary and other saints with flowers. Elsa, our third child also helps us in these activities. Small prayer services, prayer to the Guardian Angel, and lighting the candles are the daily routine of all of us before leaving home for work or studies. In the evening we sit together for the evening prayer and I believe that it is the base of the life of faith of my children.

Reception of Holy Sacraments like Holy Mass and Holy Confession are unwritten law of my family. They render us more worthy to praise and worship God. Human words are not enough to express the joy which I experience in my Catholic life. I wish all other Christian denominations to experience Jesus and love Our Blessed Mother Mary.

I request your prayers for my family and we assure you all our prayers. I thank the Diocese of Thuckalay for accepting me as her daughter and rendering my life as wonderful before the love of God and Mother Mary. "But God demonstrates his love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Since we have now been justified by His blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through Him!" (Romans 5:8-9)

#### Very Rev. Fr Augustine Thalodil A Missionary Who Builds and Nourishes Faith

Missionary priests serve the Word of God in ways suited to the uniqueness of the peoples to whom they are send to; through teaching, dialogue, prayer, celebration and the witness of their person and life. The Post-Synodal Apostolic Exhortation Pastores Dabo Vobis states that, even though belonging to a Particular Church, the priest has received a spiritual gift by virtue of his ordination, which prepares him for a universal mission, even to the ends of the earth (Cf. Acts 1:8), "for every priestly ministry shares in the universality of the mission entrusted by Christ to His apostles" (PDV 32). This magisterium of the Catholic Church realizes in the life of missionaries who render their services in the mission Diocese of Thuckalay and before in the Thekkan Mission or Kanyakumari Mission of the Archdiocese of Changanacherry since 1960. Rev Fr. Augustine Thalodil is one among these missionaries, who is specially chosen and sent by Christ Himself for His flock in Tamilnadu and especially in Kanniyakumari region.

Rev Fr. Augustine Thalodil was born on 27 October 1960 as the fourth and last child of his parents Joseph and RosammaThalodil. Thomas, Antony and Johny are his elder brothers. St. George Church, Manvettam, which is famous for the richness of religious vocations, is his parish of origin. He had completed his schooling from Government L P School Memury, NSS High





School Kallara and Government Higher Secondary School Arpookara. After the class Ten studies, he joined Good Shepherd Minor Seminary, Palai and started his formation for priesthood. Even from the very first day, he was very mature in his dealings with formators and classmates. His conviction about priestly life was expressed in his spiritual as well as human relationships. Inspired by the spiritual life of Very Rev Fr. John Thalodil, then Mission Director of the Archdiocese of Changanacherry and Forane Vicar of St. Mary's Forane Church Athirampuzha, Augustine Thalodil had always possessed a special devotion to Mother Mary. The incomparable prayer life of mother Rosamma was the powerhouse of his decision to become a priest.

He was sent to St. Thomas Apostolic Seminary, Vadavathoor for his Philosophy and Theology studies and in between he had completed his MA in English as well as practical training or regency in Bishop Vayalil Library, Palai. During these years, through reading books and prayer life he had been moulding the future minister of Christ in himself. As St. Augustine says, "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our heart is restless until it rests in you." During the formation period, Fr. Augustine prepared himself surrendering totally to the will of God. On 30 December 1989, he was ordained a priest by the imposition of hands by Mar Joseph Pallikaparampilat at Holy Ghost Forane Church, Muttuchira.

Rev Fr. Augustine Thalodil was appointed as the assistant parish priest of Holy Cross Forane Church, Cherpumkal on 10 February 1990. At the same time, he was also appointed as the Forane Director of Sunday School and Mission League. Very Rev Fr. Cyriac Kunnel, then parish priest of the Forane appreciated his selfless service and



utmost dedication to the responsibilities even at a young age. After this initial ministry, he served the Diocese for another 10 years in various parishes and positions – assistant priest at St. George Forane Church, Aruvithura and Sacred Heart Church Poovarany and then Vicar of St. Mary's Church Elappally and St Antony Church Kaippally. He had also served as CML Forane Director, SMYM Forane Director. He was an instrument in constructing the Way of the Cross Stations for the public devotion in the parishes. People continue to remember him with gratitude for all the dedicated services rendered in the Diocese for their spiritual growth.

After 10 years of his priestly ministry in Palai Diocese, in the year 2001, after the request made by the First Bishop of The Diocese Thuckalay Cardinal Mar George Alencherry to the Diocese Palai, Rev Fr. Augustine Thalodil was sent to a new land of missions for one year as the missionary in the Diocese of Thuckalay and still he continues his work in the Diocese. He had possessed a strong desire to become a missionary even during the formation period. He was a very good volunteer in prison ministry during the major seminary studies and he was deeply impacted by it. He developed an ardent heart for the poor and the needy and wished for their upliftment. This dream had come true when he reached in the land of Kanniyakumari as a missionary. The first appointment of Rev Fr. Augustine Thalodil was at Sacred Heart Forane Church, Padantalumoodu and was also teaching in the school for six years. Along with the responsibility in the Forane church and in the school, he was also appointed to look after the parishes of Thettiyode and Athencode. Awakened by the need of parishioners of Thettiyode to have a



big Church, he helped to construct a new Church. Nobody imagined at that time that he would go on to construct many churches in the Diocese of Thuckalay. Another venture that he had undertaken was the construction of Annikarai Church. Besides the Church, he had added a presbytery and parish hall. Then he was appointed as the vice-rector and procurator of the Minor Seminary at Mukkoottukal. He did not limit his pastoral field to the institution, rather he took charge also as the parish priest of Bengiri Church, which was near to the Minor Seminary. Under his guidance, the parishioners came together for the renovation of the Church and constructed a new *Kurusady* (Grotto), stage and main entrance gate.

Though Rev Fr. Augustine Thalodil was active in the parish ministries and other institutional services, he had a desire to acquire knowledge in different fields. After the term in the minor seminary, he was sent to Denhalaya Psycho-Spiritual formation Centre, Punnapra for a shortterm course. He returned to the Diocese after successful completion of the course and took charge as the parish priest of St. Francis Assisi

Church Mezhakode. There too he started constructing a new church, a new *Kurusady*, bell tower and parish hall. This time, construction was not a burden for him as he had already become an expert due to his abundant experience. He was also keen to construct spirituality in the life of parishioners. He committed himself in the evangelical mission of Church, to reach the Faith to non-Christian families.

At present, Rev Fr. Augustine Thalodil serves the Diocese as the Forane Vicar of Manjalumoodu and Parish Priest of Thettivilai. He had also undertaken the construction of St. Joseph's Church Kunnuvilai, bell tower and renovation of parish hall and completed the whole work in less than a year. Rev Fr. Augustine Thalodil has been an Ideal Missionary who constructs the church, fills the people in it and nourishes them with spirituality for the sake of the kingdom of God.

Whenever Rev Fr. Augustine Thalodil was asked about the vocation, he repeats,

Vocation is the Gift of God. He calls whom He loves the most. Jesus loves me a lot though I am not worthy to be his Priest. What I am and what I became is the gift of God. I am an instrument in the hands of God. I am proud of nothing-I haven't put my name in any of the parishes rather I put the Christian brand mark PRAISE THE LORD. I have no enemies; if someone turns against me, I pray for them. I have all confidence in prayer that they will reconcile soon. Mother Mary is my best friend who has constantly saved me from all kinds of dangers both physical and spiritual. Among the saints, I pray for the intercession of St Devasahayam and Blessed Kunjachan. For all the needs in my life I pray to the Holy Spirit. I recite one Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory be every day before wearing the cassock. If I wear ten times, I say ten times these prayers. Prayer is my strength both in joys and sorrows.

He exhorts the future missionaries, "Do not spoil what you have by desiring what you don't have; bewith the people; don't miss daily celebration of the Holy Eucharist; be close to Jesus; keep at least one hour for personal prayer; have a timetable in life and keep a balance in life."

The Diocese of Thuckalay is still vibrant and Missionary because of such priests continue to be a model and guide the younger generation to follow the suit.
