KKSSS Celebrates Women's Day in Kayathar and Viruthunagar

On 5th March 2025, the Kayathar and Viruthunagar missions came alive with vibrant Women's Day celebrations organized by KKSSS. The events were coordinated by Fr. Jomon Mangalamadam in Kayathar and Fr. Ajin C. Joseph in Viruthunagar. As part of the mission's commitment to women empowerment, KKSSS distributed 20 sewing machines to economically disadvantaged women in each location, offering them a means to support themselves through selfemployment. The programme was inaugurated by the Bishop. Fr. Joshy Kulathumkal, Fr. Aby Poovathummoottil, Fr. Subin Puthenpurackal, along with local leaders and members of the community was present. The day's celebrations also featured a range of cultural programmes and engaging activities that highlighted the talents and strength of women.









A Sacred Renewal:

Chapel Blessing at SH Convent, Mukkoottukal

On 15th March 2025, the renovated chapel of the SH Convent in Mukkoottukal was solemnly blessed by Rev. Fr. Thomas Powathuparampil, the Vicar General. The ceremony commenced at 11:00 am with the celebration of the Holy Qurbana, presided over by the Vicar General and concelebrated by Fr. Subin Puthenpurackal, Parish Priest of Mukkoottukal. The event saw the participation of all SH congregation sisters serving in the diocese, as well as priests from the parishes where SH convents are located. Following the spiritual celebration, the gathering concluded with a fellowship lunch.







Lenten Reflection Through Taizé: Youth-Led Prayer Evenings Inspire the Faithful

During the Lenten season, the SMYM organized deeply moving Taizé prayer services led by the youth. These reflective gatherings were held on 23rd March 2025 at 6:00 PM at St. Antony's Church, Vayalinkarai, for the Nithiravilai and Padanthalumoodu foranes, and on 30th March 2025 at 2:00 PM for the Thuckalay - Pilankalai forane. Around 50 young people participated in each session, engaging in heartfelt meditation on the passion, death, and crucifixion of Jesus Christ. The atmosphere of contemplative prayer offered them a unique opportunity for spiritual renewal, including the sacrament of confession.







Shaping Tomorrow's Leaders: Youth Leadership Training at SMYM Office

A one-day leadership training programme was held on 8th March 2025 at the SMYM Office, Kalluvilai, with the aim of enhancing leadership skills among the youth. The session was led by Fr. Joseph Santhosh, who focused on the unique characteristics, creative

The inaugural Migrants' Sangamam in Bangalore was held on 16th March 2025 at St. Thomas Forane Church, Dharmaram. Organized by the diocesan Migrants' Apostolate, the event opened with the solemn celebration of the Holy Qurbana, presided over by Fr.

Sumesh Valliyamthadathil, the diocesan director. Though the Bishop had intended to preside over the meeting, an unavoidable circumstance prevented his physical presence. However, his message was shared virtually with the attendees, offering encouragement and blessings. Fr. Sumesh officially inaugurated the public gathering that followed.







Mr. Edwinson efficiently coordinated the day's programme, while Miss Jasmine served as the anchor. During the gathering, Mr. Praveen and Mr. Aneesh were elected as the coordinators of Bangalore Migrants. Twenty-six participants from various parts of Bangalore introduced themselves and shared their personal experiences of life in the city. The event was graced by the presence of Rev. Fr. Anto (Vicar), Rev. Fr. Jomon (Chancellor of the Diocese of Mandya), Fr. John, and Fr. Arun, who offered their greetings and reassured the migrants of ongoing spiritual and pastoral support.

NATIONAL CONFERENCE

for secretaries of diocesan and religious health commission

A significant and spiritually enriching event—the NATIONAL CONFERENCE for secretaries of diocesan and religious health commission—was held in Bangalore under the auspices of the Catholic Bishops' Conference of India (CBCI) for Health Care. The conference brought together a diverse gathering of bishops, priests, religious superiors, and lay leaders from across the country, representing various dioceses and religious congregations.

Over several days of sessions, the participants engaged in deep discussions on current pastoral challenges, inter-congregational cooperation, missionary strategies, and the role of religious life in responding to the emerging needs of the Church and society in India. Workshops and panel discussions provided insights into best practices in evangelization, youth ministry, education, healthcare, and social justice. The Diocese of Thuckalay, represented by its bishop and delegates, actively participated in the conference, sharing its missionary experiences and drawing inspiration from the national gathering.

As part of the diocesan initiative to strengthen pastoral health care outreach in the parishes, the **election of Health Care Committee members** was successfully conducted in various parishes across the Diocese under the leadership of **Fr. Subin Puthenpurackal**, the Diocesan Director of Health Care Ministry.

The elections were coordinated and animated by **Sr. Missi Maria**, who visited several parishes and prayerfully guided the selection process. This move aimed to decentralize and empower local communities to take active roles in the physical and emotional well-being of their members, especially the sick, elderly, and homebound.

Parish-level meetings were held with the support of parish priests and lay leaders to ensure transparency and representation. The newly elected members will be responsible for coordinating medical assistance, organizing health awareness programs, facilitating regular visits to the sick, and ensuring the spiritual and sacramental needs of the ailing are met.

The Feast of St. Joseph, celebrated on 19 March 2025, was marked with deep devotion and festivity in various parishes across the Diocese of Thuckalay. As the patron of the Universal Church and model of humble service, St. Joseph was honoured with special liturgical celebrations and community gatherings. Parishes dedicated to St. Joseph

observed the feast with novena prayers, Eucharistic celebrations, and vibrant cultural programs. Faithful in large numbers gathered to participate in the Holy Qurbana, during which special intentions were offered for families, workers, and the sick, entrusting them to the intercession of St. Joseph.





Farewell to a Faithful Servant Rev. Fr. Jose Koolipurackal CMI (1949-2025)

With deep sorrow, the Diocese received the news of the passing of Rev. Fr. Jose Koolipurackal CMI on 29th March 2025, at the age of 74. Upon hearing the sad news, members of the diocesan curia and priests from nearby foranes gathered at Kaliyal, where they prayed the Office of the Dead, offering their last respects.

The mortal remains of Fr. Jose were transported from Kaliyal to Rita's Hospital, Nalukody, by 12:30 PM the same day. A native of Chambakulam, Fr. Jose had spent nearly five years at St. Mary's CMI Bhavan, Kaliyal, offering dedicated pastoral assistance to the parish priest and extending his support to

neighbouring parishes as well. Fr. Jose's missionary zeal extended beyond spiritual care—while serving as the counsellor for social service activities in the CMI Trivandrum Province, he launched initiatives to create job opportunities for women in Pilankalai in 1988 and also helped secure housing for poor families in the region. His compassionate contributions left a lasting impact on the lives of many. The funeral rites were held on 31st March 2025 at 2:00 PM at the Sacred Heart Monastery Church, Chethipuzha. The Bishop presided over the final part of the ceremonies, commending the soul of Fr. Jose to the eternal embrace of the Lord.





A Life of Grace and Dedication: Farewell to Rev. Sr. Alice Vigi CMC (1953-2025)



and unwavering commitment to the mission of the Church, especially within the Diocese of Thuckalay, where she served faithfully for 12 years. Sr. Alice Vigi CMC began her journey in the diocese on 3rd March 2013, initially taking charge as the Regional Superior of the CMC congregation. With the elevation of the region to a Vice Province, she was appointed as its first Vice Provincial. Later, in 2019, when the Vice Province attained full Province status, Sr. Alice Vigi CMC became the first Provincial of the newly established CMC Chavara Province, Thuckalay. From 2022, she served as the House Superior of the CMC Convent in Chithankudiyiruppu, continuing to inspire with her simplicity, strength, and prayerful presence.

Her tireless efforts were instrumental in the growth and establishment of the CMC Province in Thuckalay. She offered invaluable spiritual and financial support to the diocese, nurtured vocations, and sent committed sisters to serve in various apostolates, especially in education,

health care, and parish ministry. Her legacy remains etched in the fabric of the diocese. The mortal remains of Sr. Alice Vigi CMC were kept for final respects at Carmel Villa (Carmel Mount Retreat Centre, near St. Thomas Hospital, Chethipuzha, Changanacherry) on 18th March 2025. The funeral services began at 10:00 AM on 19th March 2025. The Bishop presided over the Holy Qurbana and the final rites, which were concelebrated by Rev. Fr. Antony Elamthottam CMI (Provincial), Rev. Fr. Thomas Powathuparampil, Rev. Fr. Joshy Kulathumkal, Rev. Fr. Mathew Arekalam CMI, and several priests from the Diocese of Thuckalay.

The services were attended by a large number of priests, religious sisters, and lay faithful who came to pray and pay their last respects. The diocese extends its heartfelt condolences and prayers to the sisters of the CMC Chavara Province.



A Grateful Farewell to a Faithful Servant: Rev. Sr. Bridget Paul Thekeparambil SDS (1948–2025)



With heartfelt sorrow, the Diocese of Thuckalay received the news of the passing of Rev. Sr. Bridget Paul Thekeparambil SDS on 21st March 2025, at the age of 77. A native of St. Sebastian's Church, Mutholapuram, in the Diocese of Palai, Sr. Bridget lived a life wholly dedicated to the service of God and His people, spending a total of 18 fruitful years in pastoral and missionary work within the Diocese of Thuckalay. Her ministry began in Karode, where she served from 1980 to 1987, offering her time and energy for the growth of the local Church. She later served in

Manjalumoodu from 2003 to 2012, and again from 2023 until her passing, providing constant support to the faithful through her prayer, presence, and compassion. Her life was marked by simplicity, dedication, and a deep love for the people she served.

The funeral rites were held on 24th March 2025 at 10:00 AM at the SDS Convent Chapel in Manjalumoodu. The initial parts of the ceremony were presided over by Rev. Fr. Joshy Kulathumkal, while the Bishop presided over the Holy Qurbana and the concluding funeral rites.



A Humble Life in Service: Farewell to Rev. Sr. Elsy Mathew Chengandayil SDS (1945–2025)




With deep sadness, the Diocese of Thuckalay received the news of the passing of Rev. Sr. Elsy Mathew Chengandayil SDS on 20th March 2025, at the age of 79. A native of St. Joseph's Church, Chennamkary, Sr. Elsy devoted her life to religious service, offering her presence, prayer, and pastoral care across various mission centers.

Her ministry spanned several locations, including Bangalore, Kandanvilai, Pulluvilai, Mysore, and Aruvikkara, where she served with humility and dedication. In the final months of her life, due to ill health, Sr. Elsy was under medical care at the SDS Convent in Manjalumoodu, where she spent her last days surrounded by her religious community. The funeral service was held on 21st March 2025 at 11:00 AM at the SDS Convent Chapel, Manjalumoodu. The initial parts of the service were led by Rev. Fr. Joshy Kulathumkal, and the Bishop presided over the Holy Qurbana and the concluding funeral rites.
