

Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,

Greetings and prayerful wishes from Diocese of Thuckalay.

It's a **GOOD & GREAT TIDING.** JESUS IS BORN! On the Day of Christmas, during the Eucharist, we gather around the little Babe of Bethlehem. It is my privilege to wish you a Merry Christmas. May the joy and peace of the Lord Jesus always be in your hearts and your homes as it is on Christmas Day. Every newborn child is a wonder, a mystery, a gift of God. No matter whether the family is wealthy or poor, whether the child is the firstborn or the latest in the long line, all who gather around are moved. We smile, cry, laugh, bring a gift, and wish happiness and peace for the little one. For us, this Child is a sign of hope and faith in the future.

This season tells us that Emmanuel - God with us - left His Divinity to enter into our humanity to raise us to a higher level, a higher purpose, to transform our lives, to redirect our lives, and to plant our feet on higher and solid ground. When we understand the real value of Advent in our lives, we would be led into a much greater understanding and appreciation for Christmas; and when we have a greater understanding and appreciation of these two seasons, we will find ourselves in the place where we can no longer think only of cards and cribs and cakes but move beyond it, recognizing God in ourselves and especially in the working of God in history and the people. Christmas is about a definitive moment in time, in human history, when God showed that He cares for every one of us by entering into our humanity so that He could walk with us, live with us, lead us, carry us and lift us to that better place. It is, therefore, not just about celebrations, but rather about the love of our God who wanted to become one with us so deeply, that He gave up His Divinity to enter into our wretched humanity.

Christmas - the birth of God in a poor manger - is the most celebrated feast in this world. Christmas offers us all an opportunity to recapture glimpses of childhood's sacred memories. There is a timelessness about gazing into the crib and coming face to face with the truth that God came

down from heaven and dwelt among us as a helpless baby Jesus. The Gospel tells us that, at Bethlehem, on a starry night the Son of God was born. A burst of light startled the shepherds, and angels sang at His birth. It is the simplicity of this event that captures the imagination. Christmas is more than a story that is told—it is about a birth that brings Heaven right down to earth. Love came down at Christmas, broke the sacred barrier between creature and Creator and gave eternal value to our lives. God has given us the gift of reaching beyond ourselves and discovering the joy of heaven.

Along with our Blessed Mother let us prepare ourselves to welcome Child Jesus. He comes knocking. He stoops low and invites us to find Him in the lowly places of our own lives, in the lowly places of our own families, and in the lowly places of this world. In our lives, what are the things, that may be crowding out Jesus; what obstacles and preoccupations leave little or no room for him; what keeps us from recognizing Jesus and opening the door wide when He comes? If we have already openedthe door to Him for many years, praise God and ask the Lord to help us to open wider. Even though many of us have invited Jesus in, we have given Him poor accommodations, perhaps relegating Him to the couch or the floor. Let us hold on to Him who is born as a human to show us the way to the Father.

I wish all the readers, friends and benefactors MERRY CHRISTMAS and GRACE FILLED NEW YEAR 2023.





Mission Quest

Seminar on Diocesan Assembly

His Excellency Mar George Rajendran sdb had sent out the Decree of Convocation of the First Diocesan Assembly during 28-30 September 2023. As a remote preparation, a seminar was organized at Sangamam on 26 November 2022 for a selected group of persons among priests, religious and laity. Provincials and delegates from congregations, representatives from the Pastoral Council, Youth and *Mathru Jyothis* (Mothers Movement). Rev. Fr. Jose Ettolil from the Archdiocese of Changanacherry animated the seminar and gave a detailed presentation of everything related to the Diocesan Assembly and provided practical suggestions on the procedure of conducting it. In the interactions and discussions that were pursued, participants shared some relevant themes for discussion in the Assembly. We pray that the Lord continues to shower His abundant blessings in the preparation and process.





Pastoral Council Meet

The Pastoral Council meeting of the Diocese Thuckalay was held at Sangamam on 01 November 2022. In the absence of His Excellency Mar George Rajendran SDB, with a special mandate Very Rev. Fr. VOCATION AND MISSION

Rev. Fr. Jose Paul Purayidathikunnel Persistent in the Divine Call

Rev. Fr Jose Paul Purayidathikunnel, an young priest of the Diocese of Thuckalay shares his life and vocation straight from his heart.

I was born on 19 June 1989 as the third child to my parents. First, let me say with joy and pride that my family is a joint family. My childhood was spend with my grand parents, my aunt and her family and my family living in the same house. My parents are Paul Abraham and Molly Paul Purayidathikunnel. My father





is a businessman and my mother is a home maker. My native parish is St. Joseph's Church, Kannimala, which belongs to the Diocese of Kanjirappally. I remember my childhood very vividly with great joy and enthusiasm. Even though we are living in the land of Lord Ayyappa, the Hindu God, my parents have strong Catholic faith. My grandmother and aunt influenced me a lot to direct my life toward ecclesiastical functions, especially how to participate in the Holy Mass and other Sacraments of the Church. As a homemaker, my mother was greatly influenced by the great homemaker Blessed Virgin Mary. My mother's life induced in me a special piety towards Mother Mary.

During my schooling, my great inspirations were the teachers and my friends. The treasure of my schooling was the deep friendship that I had with many, especially the friendship with Aby, a man of care. Till 7th standard, I studied at St. James U P School, Kannimala, and then went to St. Antony's School, Mundakayam to continue high school studies.

Even though I wished to join the minor seminary after the completion of 10th standard, I could not do so. Then I joined the SNDP HS School for higher studies. After the completion of 12th standard, I wished to join the minor seminary of the Diocese of Kanjirappally, but my parents had not allowed me to do this. So I joined St. Dominic's College, Kanjirappally for my graduation. When I joined the department of Mathematics, I had a strong desire to become an Astronaut. For achieving this goal, I joined Ponjesly College of Engineering, Nagercoil, after the completion of my first graduation.

During this time a great change had taken place in my life. During my stay with my cousin, Rev. Fr Thomas Thekkeyil, a priest in the Diocese of Thuckalay, I could witness the life of a priest and then, I changed my desire to become an astronaut and once again, a strong desire filled me to become a holy priest. When I informed my desire to Rev. Fr Thekkeyil, he was struck with wonder and his interaction with me showed that he was truly confused. I

waited for a month and I spoke to him again about the same. Probably he found in this young man some seriousness about what I had expressed. He bought me to the then Bishop of Thuckalay and the present Major Archbishop, His Beatitude Mar George Cardinal Alencherry. When I informed him about my vocation to the priesthood, he invited me to the minor seminary of the mission Diocese of Thuckaly. These things happened while I was studying in my second year of Engineering.

When my parents knew about this decision, they were disappointed and strongly opposed my decision. For them, this decision was very painful. In spite of the objection from my family, I officially joined the minor seminary immediately after the completion of the engineering course. After the studies in the minor seminary, the Diocese sent me to St. Thomas Apostolic Seminary, Vadavathoor, Kottayam. I did my Philosophy and Theology from the same institution. This formation strengthened my vocation and formed me in my journey to priesthood.



The life at St. Thomas was a great opportunity and a gift of God. It helped me to grow in understanding and diligence. I learnt the heritage of the Syro-Malabar Church in a special manner and learnt a lot about the special liturgy. During the formation period, I had undergone so many struggles from different sides. I considered all these struggles and the subsequent corrections were the intervention of Holy Spirit and tried my level best to form myself.

During the years of my formation, I was influenced by Rev. Fr Varghese Kochuparambil, a priest from the Diocese of Kanjirappally. He had a clear vision about priestly formation and priesthood. Because of this reason, I took him as my Spiritual Confessor. When I opened my self to him, he made me as his own and helped me as his own younger brother. I am very happy to continue this relationship.

Once my seminary formation was over and my bishop decided to accept me to the eternal priesthood of Christ, I said 'Yes' to the will of God to offer myself totally for His service in the Diocese of Thuckalay. I was ordained on 20 April 2022 at St. Mathew's Church, Annikarai. Today I serve our Diocese as the Assistant Parish Priest at St. Joseph's Forane Church and Assistant Correspondent of A P J M Matriculation Higher Secondary School, Soosaipuram.

Today, I can reflect and find what influenced me to offer myself for the service of the Lord. It is the saintly life of many priests that I have come across at different stages of my life, and of course, the prayer life of my mother.

I urge our young friends in Catholic Faith not to be afraid of the world but to open your hearts to Jesus and to listen to His Inner Voice to share His Eternal Priesthood and to serve the world through the Church.
