





On October 4, 2023, Bishop Mar George Rajendran SDB visited DNN in Karode, on October 30, 2023, Karunailllam in Nithiravilai, and on October 31, 2023 and Nambikkai Alayam in Kazhuvanthittai. The pastoral visits commenced with the celebration of Holy Qurbana and continued throughout the day. During these visits, Rev. Bishop personally met with the directors, administrators, staff, students, and benefactors, as well as review the relevant documents and the maintenance of the facilities. 

### **Department Directors' Meet at Bishop's House**



Following the transfers that became effective on May 24, 2023, Rev. Bishop met with the Directors and Forane Directors of each department for the first time.

During these meetings, the directors evaluated the current activities and offered suggestions to enhance coordination. It was unanimously recognized that there is a need for effective coordination at the Forane level and for strengthening the role of Forane Directors in the respective departments. The Forane Directors were tasked with presenting these recommendations during the upcoming Forane Priests' Conferences and engaging all Parish Priests in these activities.







On 11 October 2023, an eye camp was held at KKSSS, Kalluvilai in collaboration with Samco Eye Hospital, Vettumany. Seventy-two people benefited from this camp. KKSSS also organized a Siddha medical camp at Kalluvilai in collaboration with Atsvs Siddha Medical College in the afternoon, benefiting 80 individuals.





## **Medical Camp at Cumbum**

On October 15, 2023, a free medical camp was conducted in Angurpalayam, Cumbum, through the joint efforts of Cumbum Sacred Heart Mission and Medical Trust Hospital, Mundakkayam. The camp saw the participation of two doctors, namely Dr. S. Arul Xavier and Dr. S. Thomas Chandi, who provided medical consultations to numerous residents from the village.









This year, the annual retreat took place for the first time at Snehavilla, Moolamattam, from October 15 to October 20, 2023. Rev. Fr. Stephen Thachil CMI and his team from Carmel Retreat Centre, Dharmapuri, animated the retreat. They guided the Priests in recognizing and appreciating the shared priesthood of Jesus and in leading a holy life. The retreat preacher focused on various

themes including Holiness, Priestly communion, the Importance of Prayer, Evangelization, and the power of the Word of God in our mission. A total of 41 priests along withBishop participated in the retreat. All priests who attended the retreat experienced a renewal of enthusiasm for their dedicated priestly life. 
### Last respects to

### Very Rev. Fr. Thomas Muttathukunnel

: With profound sadness, we received the unfortunate news of the passing of the pioneering missionary of our diocese, Fr. Thomas Muttathukunnel, on October 22, 2023. As a diocese deeply indebted to the Archdiocese of Changanacherry, we wish to express our heartfelt condolences and offer our prayers. We had the opportunity to pay our final respects to this great soul of our diocese when his body was taken to his house in Ponkunnam on Tuesday, October 25. From that point onward, and until the conclusion of the funeral, our Vicar General, Rev. Fr. Thomas Powthuparampil, actively participated in all the events. The funeral ceremony itself took place at 1:00 pm on October 26, 2023, at Sacred Heart Forane Church in Ponkunnam. Travel arrangements were organized by the Diocesan Procurator, Forane Vicars, and the Parish Priests of the parishes where Fr. Thomas served, and a large number of Priests, Sisters, and lay faithful attended the funeral. Approximately 250 faithful

from our diocese participated. The first and second parts of the funeral ceremony were conducted by me, while the third and fourth parts were presided over by Mar Joseph Perumthottam, the Archbishop of Changanacherry. During the Holy Qurbana presided by the Archbishop and Rev. Bishop of Thuckalay, delivered the homily.

Fr. Thomas Muttathukunnel was a pioneering missionary who dedicated himself tirelessly to the advancement of the Kingdom of God and played a pivotal role in the development of the Kanyakumari mission. Later, he served as the Vicar General of the Diocese of Thuckalay. Following his priestly ordination on December 20, 1960, he arrived in the Kanyakumari mission in January 1961, and he wholeheartedly devoted his entire priestly ministry to this mission until his retirement to the Archdiocese of Changanacherry in 2004. With commitment and




missionary zeal, he served for 43 years in the soil of Kanyakumari. During these years, he served as Parish Priest in 15 different mission places, including Nithiravilai, Padanthalumoodu, Soosaipuram, Vayalinkarai, Palukal, Manjalumoodu, Palappallam, Mankarai, Pilankarai, Karode, Mukkoottukal, Marappady, Thettiyode, Thakkalivilai, and Varuthattu. He also served for many years as the President of KKSSS and as the spiritual director of the Vincent de Paul

Society and the Legion of Mary. During these periods, he served the mission as the district mission coordinator and Kanyakumari mission coordinator. When the Diocese of Thuckalay was established, he was appointed as its first Vicar General and served the diocese for 7 years until his retirement in 2004. The Diocese of Thuckalay is truly grateful to Fr. Thomas Muttathukunnel for his selfless dedication and prays for his eternal rewards.
