The day was packed with useful and practical sessions on the role and responsibilities of Kaikars. All the members appreciated the program and actively took part in the group discussions. Many of them did not have the clear knowledge of their position; they expressed the hope that the diocese will organize such a program annually. May I remind the fathers to conduct the election of Kaikkars in the month of April so as to enable them to take part in the seminar organized for them in May. I wish to thank Rev. Fr. Mathew Thekkekutt and Rev. Fr. Christudas for organizing the program and being the resource persons for the seminar.

## **OVERNIGHT CAMPS**

Forane level overnight camp for boys and a daylong seminar for girls of classes 10 and 12 were organized. This was to orient boys and girls towards their future life and study. The chief intention was to recognize vocation to priesthood and religious life. Unfortunately all the parishes did not send the candidates. I would like to thank all the fathers who have generously sponsored food and also made sufficient arrangements for the camp. Special thanks to Rev. Fr. Dency, Fr. Mijo, Rev. Brothers and Rev. Fr. Benedict Analin for organizing such a program.

#### **VOCATION CAMP**

The annual vocation camp for boys was held from 15-20, May 2013 at Sangamam. There were 17 boys from Kerala and from our diocese. The Vocation camp for Girls was held on 21<sup>st</sup> May 2013 at Sangamam. There were 28 girls from various parishes attended the camp. At the end of the camp, sisters from various religious congregations were asked to present their congregation along with their charism. We pray that a good many of our boys and girls from our diocese will join us to become priests and religious. It was a very good turnout and I am grateful to all of you for promoting vocation to priesthood and religious life. I see that there is a sufficient amount of awareness among the parents and children regarding the need for vocation. I am sure this should continue in our parishes and centers. Lets cultivate vocations, spot the alter boys from the lower classes on wards and prepare them. By next year, each parish should contribute at least one candidate for priesthood and religious life. #### MINOR SEMINARY

As you know Rev. Fr. James Aikkaramattam, the Rector took leave of the seminary on 17<sup>th</sup> May and Rev. Fr. Tom Kunnumpuram will take charge as the new Rector of the same on 28<sup>th</sup> May. We wish him all the best and God's blessing. We have 19 minor seminary students belonging to 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year. These days they are taking part in the spoken English program conducted by British English academy, Nagercoil. The first year students will join on 3<sup>rd</sup>June 2013. We have done a small renovation work in the dormitory of the brothers. Rev. Bro. Ritto is appointed as the full time assistant to the brothers. The academic year for the seminary begins on 5<sup>th</sup> June, at 10.00 am in the Minor seminary, I request as many fathers as possible to attend the inaugural program especially fathers belong to Manjalumoodu Forane. I wish to thank all the seminary staff for their dedication and hard work in order to form the seminarians according to the directives of the church.

### MY SHILLONG VISIT

I visited Shillong and Guwahati from 8<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> May 2013. It was an opportunity to thank all the Salesian confreres and people.
